Weingarten rights

As an employee represented by a union, you have the right under the National Labor Relations Act right to have a representative with you during an interview if there is the possibility of discipline. This might be with an administrator, a member of law enforcement, or an appointed investigator. In such a case, simply tell the person requesting the interview:

“I am a member of MSCF. If this discussion could in any way lead to my being disciplined or terminated, or affect my personal working condition, I respectfully request that my union representative be present at the meeting. I will not answer questions until I have had an opportunity to seek advice from my union.”
